

Android and iOS Devices


1. Open the Apple Store or Google Play Store and Search for Libby.

- Once found in the store, select download/install and then open.
- You may be asked to 'Authorize' your device.




2. All differences between Android and iOS instructions end here. Read the colorful text, scroll down, and then select 'Find My Library.'

- You can also sign in with your Overdrive account by selecting the option at the bottom of the page.



3. Search by zip code or search around the map to bring up your library.

- You may need to enable location services for the map to find the library.
- If location services is on, and you are nearby the library, it may come up automatically.




6. On the main Libby page, select 'Add Your Card.'

- Select 'Sign In.'
- Select Villa Park Public Library from the list.



- Add your library card and library pin, then select 'Sign In.'
- Libby will once again give you the choice of signing in with your older Overdrive account instead of making a Libby alternate. These accounts are one in the same.


7. Once you are signed in, you may begin searching for titles to checkout or place on hold.

- Find titles by using the search bar or browse genres.




8. When you have chosen a title to check out, select 'Borrow.'

- If the title is listed as 'Place on Hold,' select it and input an email address so you can be notified when it becomes available.



9. Once a title has been borrowed, select 'Open Book' and begin reading!

- You can manipulate your font brightness, chapters and more by selecting the bottom of the book or audiobook when it is open.



10. To view all the titles on your bookshelf, renew items, view holds, and more, select 'Shelf' at the bottom of the page.

- Titles can also be renewed by selecting the cover of the book to bring up more options.
