The Board of Trustees of the Villa Park Public Library is now accepting proposals from qualified environmental firms for the scope of work detailed in the request for proposal document. A specialty contractor who is trained, licensed, and insured for this type of work is needed to perform the testing and potential abatement. The Illinois EPA requires a ten (10) day notice for abatement projects, in addition to the removal time.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Villa Park Public Library has determined the current facility at 24,000 square feet no longer provides adequate space to serve the Library's residents. The Library is anticipating that the required space will be approximately 34,000 square feet with a new parking lot with 55 spaces. A referendum for this project was passed in 2016.

A Phase I ESA for the site must include a review of records, site inspection, interviews, and historical research of the property and adjacent properties and a report. The work shall identify any potential environmental contamination liabilities. If the potential for contaminated soils is found, then it will be necessary to perform a Phase II ESA, which involves sample collection, analysis, and identification of hazards.
