



On May 1, the Villa Park Public Library will join the SWAN Library Consortium.

Our library community is growing! On May 1 we will be joining the SWAN library consortium. While we are busy working to make this transition as easy as possible for you, it is important to share a few ways you might be impacted by this change.

April 18-May 1, 2018 – Partial Catalog Freeze

During this period, our library cannot add new material to the library catalog. This means you will see a delay in adding the latest Best Sellers to our shelves.

April 28-May 1, 2018 – “Checkout-Only” Period

During this time, you can check out and return material but that activity will not be reflected immediately in My Account in the online catalog. There may also be interruption to online services.
