

Villa Park Public Library – Addition and Renovation Project Construction Material Testing & Special Inspections Services – Request for Proposal Date: March 22, 2018

Dear Prospective Bidder,

On behalf of the Board of Trustees of the Villa Park Public Library we are requesting sealed proposals or e-mailed proposals for construction materials testing services and special inspections services for the new addition and renovation project at the Villa Park Public Library located at 305 Ardmore Ave. Villa Park, IL 60181.

# PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

This is a phased library project with the construction of a 9300 SQFT addition and parking lot as phase 1 followed by the renovation of an existing 24,500 SQFT building. The library will remain operational throughout the construction period.

Project construction value is approximately \$7 Million.

- Union work is required; please verify union work will be utilized within proposal.
- Construction is scheduled to begin in May 2018. A 12 month construction period is anticipated.
- Construction material testing services and special inspections services included within the scope of work of this RFP will commence in May, 2018 and continue as may be required for 12 months.
- Services will be contracted by the Villa Park Public Library either by PO or contract.
- Services will be coordinated with the project's GC.

The project will require, among other items, material testing and special inspections of the following components per the 2009 edition of the International Building Code as adopted by the Village of Villa Park.

- 3) Sections 031000, 032000, 033000, 034100
- 4) Section 042200
- 5) Section 078100
- 6) Asphalt Testing
- 7) Other Tests as needed

- Earthwork / Foundations
- Steel Construction
- Concrete Construction
- Masonry Construction
- Applied Fireproofing

Also, parts of this RFP are the following documents:

- Exhibit A Material Testing and Special Inspections Specifications.
- Exhibit B Architectural, Civil and Structural Drawings.

All material testing and special inspections must conform to specifications and code as described. A set of construction document drawings prepared by Williams Architect delineating the scope of the project is available for <u>review only</u> at the Villa Park Public Library located at 305 Ardmore Ave. Villa Park, IL 60181.

Please review Exhibit A and Exhibit B and include any additional required tests or related information in your submitted proposal.

### PROPOSAL FORMAT:

Please submit a fee breakdown structure, consistent with the categories of material testing and special inspections listed above.

The proposal should be complete and include itemization of the various types of tests and inspections that will be performed, hourly wage rates and services provided for each category of material testing and special inspections.

Your Proposal should include:

- Field Services including
  - Hourly Wage Rates
  - Equipment Charges
  - Travel Costs
    - Please note that overtime will not be allowed for travel time
    - Cylinder pickup charge
  - Reimbursables
  - o Overtime Rate
- Laboratory Testing
- Consulting / Engineering Services including
  - Hourly Wage Rates
  - o Report Preparation
  - o Office Support, etc.
  - Reimbursables
  - o Any minimum charge per day or hours per day

Please include a total material testing and special inspections services BUDGET for the entire project.
