Roll Call Votes

Whenever a roll call vote is taken at a Library Board meeting, the minutes of the meeting shall record the name of each Board member and his or her vote. This information may be needed for future reference.

If a motion is to be rescinded, one of the members voting with the majority must start the process. A record in the minutes of names and votes will make it easy to establish eligibility in such a case.

Therefore, whenever a vote is not unanimous, a roll call shall be taken, with a name-vote record stated in the minutes.
