## *Shadow of the Shark* by Mary Pope Osborne

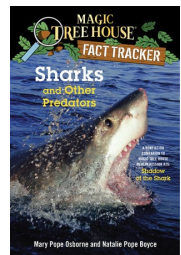

## *Sharks and Other Predators* by Mary Pope Osborne and Natalie Pope Boyce

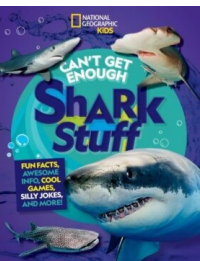

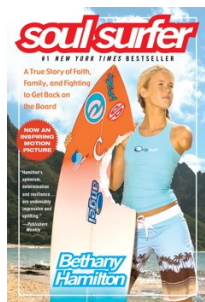
