Noise Level Zones

The Villa Park Public Library is committed to providing spaces that serve the diverse needs of our users. In order to provide an environment that is conducive to quiet study, reading and collaboration, the library is divided into noise level zones.

In all zones, mobile devices should never be loud enough to disturb other people.

SILENT ZONE: In this zone, only silent, independent reading and study is allowed. Users may not converse. Electronics may be used with earbuds or headphones at a low volume. Cell phones should be on vibrate or silenced. Library Silent Zone: Second Floor Reading Room.

QUIET ZONE: In this zone, users may have quiet conversations. Cell phones should be on vibrate or silenced. Electronics may be used with earbuds or headphones at a low volume. Library Quiet Zones: Second floor book and audiovisual areas.

TALK ZONE: In this zone, users may converse at a moderate volume, have quiet cell phone conversations, and work collaboratively. Electronics may be used with earbuds or headphones. Library Talk Zones: First floor lobby, Youth Services Department and study rooms; Second floor service desk, computer and study area, teen area, group collaboration room, digital media lab, and study rooms.
