

Policy 568.2 / Building Use

Patrons Belongings

Wheeled Items

Items with wheels are allowed in the Villa Park Public Library when utilized for their intended purpose. Items include, but are not limited to:

- Strollers
- Wheelchairs
- Personal mobility scooters
- Walkers
- Luggage
- Pull shopping carts
- Skateboards, kick scooters, and fold-up bicycles are only allowed if carried. Bicycles should be parked in the bicycle rack area on the east or west side of the library.

Oversized Items

Oversized items are generally allowed if they do not obstruct walkways, public areas, or create a safety hazard. Allowable items include, but are not limited to:

- Musical Instruments
- Artist Portfolios
- Architectural Document Tubes
- Sports Equipment

Unattended items

The Library prohibits patrons from leaving their belongings unattended for extended periods while using the Library. Belongings should stay with the owner and not occupy a separate table or chair. Unattended and apparently abandoned property is subject to confiscation and disposal by the Library in accordance with Illinois statutes applicable to lost, abandoned, or unclaimed property. Staff members are not responsible for monitoring patron belongings.

Lost, Stolen or Damaged Property

The Library is not responsible for personal items which are lost, stolen, or damaged in or on the library grounds. Any belonging may be forbidden if it presents a potential health or safety risk for patrons and/or library staff.
