The library hosted four blood drives, helping save up to **138** lives through community participation. These events brought people together to support a shared community health effort.

1,126 Books were added to the library's nine Little Free Library locations. This outreach effort helped place books directly into the community and supported broader access to library resources.

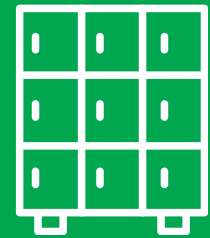
The library processed 580 passports, generating \$20,300 in revenue through the service.
